

GENERAL TOUR GUIDELINES:

For everyone's safety and protection, we ask for complete cooperation and assistance in observing these basic rules. This is a working facility and production must continue; therefore these safety rules must be followed.

- 1) Wear closed-toed shoes.
- 2) Always listen to the instructions of your tour guide.
- 3) Stay close together as a group. It is safer for everyone and allows you to hear the tour guide.
- 4) Children must stay between the tour guide and the adult at the rear of the group at all times.
- 5) Watch for traffic and moving equipment at all times.
- 6) Do not run.
- 7) Do not touch or pick up anything. All material should be considered unsafe to touch.
- 8) Have fun and be sure to ask a lot of questions!

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1) Bring a bandana(s) to mask your face from dust and smells and/or to use under the hardhat helmet (note: shared helmets are sanitized with a child-safe, non-toxic spray after each use.)
- 2) If you are allergic to bees/wasps we recommend bringing an EpiPen for emergencies as there are often bees buzzing around the aluminum bales.

PARKING POLICY:

- 1) Please arrange for carpooling as there is limited parking available onsite.
- 2) Please park in the designated parking spaces along the curb in front of the grassy area outside of the Transfer station (just past "Flying Can Ranch" on your left). The tour guide will be waiting outside in a bright orange vest to help you with parking.
- 3) If you are arriving by bus or van, please notify the Schools & Community Coordinator prior to the tour so that proper parking can be arranged.
